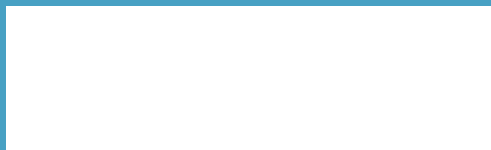

What is the ISAC Alumni Association?

The Iowa State Association of Counties' Alumni Association was established in 1993 by Jack Foresman, former Cherokee County Supervisor, and Bev Anderson – Ziemann, Cherokee County Auditor. Approved by the ISAC Board of Directors, this group is intended to:

- ◆ Help county government solve issues and problems;
- ◆ Provide constructive discussion at meetings;
- ◆ Serve on panels in an advisory capacity, such as participation in ISAC Steering Committee meetings (as a non-voting member); and
- ◆ Offer experience and wisdom to current county officials.

Who is Eligible To Join?

Anyone who is a former elected or appointed county employee is eligible to join. The dues are \$25 per year. Members receive a subscription to *The Iowa County* magazine and an invitation to the ISAC Schools (free registration and same sleeping room rates as other attendees.) *The Iowa County* magazine will keep you current with county issues and include information about ISAC Alumni Association activities.

Alumni meetings are held during the ISAC Fall School of Instruction and the ISAC Spring School of Instruction. Other meetings are held throughout the year as needed.
