Applicants must be registered to vote in Lee County at the time he/she assumes the position and must be admitted to practice law in the state of Iowa. This position is a full-time position where the successful applicant will prosecute violations of state criminal law and county ordinances; provide legal advice to the Board of Supervisors; represent and defend the state, county and its officers in officially related cases; and other duties assigned pursuant to Iowa laws. Candidates must have strong written and verbal communication skills; litigation skills are preferred.
