The executive director serves as the chief executive officer of the agency and is responsible for the overall management of the fiscal, personnel, and policy functions of the agency. The executive director serves as the primary person responsible for overall public relations to local governments and the region on behalf of the agency's board of directors. NIACOG also serves as the regional transit authority. Candidates must possess a Bachelor's degree (Master's preferred) from an accredited college or university in planning, public administration or a related field and at least five or more years of professional experience in planning and/or public administration that includes progressively responsible administration. NIACOG is governed by a board of directors composed of elected officials and private citizens. NIACOG was created to promote regional cooperation and to provide professional planning services to local governments in an 8-county region in north central Iowa.
