County Engineer

The Floyd County Board of Supervisors is seeking qualified applicants for a full-time County Engineer. Position requires valid State of Iowa certificate of registration as a professional engineer. Four or more years of experience in civil engineering work is preferred.

The County Engineer is responsible for:

Engineer plans; coordinate, assign and supervise all engineering and construction work performed by the county secondary roads department and independent contractors; prepare and let contract documents for projects; present an annual budget; prepare five-year construction program identifying future bridge and road improvement projects; supervise personnel; work with union representatives on employment matters; establish effective working relationships with other government agencies, other county departments, contractors and the public; oversight of collection site department; Title VI administrator.

Starting salary: \$100,000 to \$120,000, pending education and experience, plus benefits.
