

The Wayne County Board of Supervisors is seeking applicants for the position of Wayne County Engineer. The county is led by a three-person board of supervisors. Applicants must have an Iowa Professional Engineering License in Civil or Construction Engineering or be able to obtain the license within two years. Possession of a Land Surveyor's License would also be beneficial but is not required. The engineer plans, coordinates, assigns, and supervises all engineering and construction work performed by the county secondary roads department and independent contractors. In addition, the Engineer will prepare and let contract documents for projects, present an annual budget and a five-year construction program identifying future road improvement projects, and work with union representatives on employment matters. The ability to establish and maintain an effective working relationship with department personnel, other government agencies, other county departments, contractors, and the public is essential.
