

## **Washington County Attorney Vacancy**

The Washington County Board of Supervisors is taking applications for the position of Washington County Attorney, which will be vacant January 29, 2023. The specific job duties and requirements are described in Iowa Code 331.756.

The person selected for this position must be a registered voter in Washington County, be admitted to practice law in Iowa as provided by law, and qualify by taking the oath of office as provided in Iowa Code sections 63.10 and 64.8.

The Board of Supervisors intends to proceed with appointment instead of a special election, and to make the appointment as soon as March 10, 2023. The appointee will serve in the position until the next General election.

Employment applications may be acquired from the Washington County Auditor's office on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the Washington County Courthouse between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, or found online at <https://washingtoncounty.iowa.gov/jobs.aspx>. Applications and resumes must be submitted by delivery to the Washington County Auditor's office, Attention: Amber Armbruster, at 222 W. Main St., Washington (Courthouse) or submitted electronically to [aarmbruster@co.washington.ia.us](mailto:aarmbruster@co.washington.ia.us) by February 3, 2023 by 4:30 p.m.

While the Washington County Board of Supervisors intends to fill this vacancy by appointment, the electors of Washington County have the right to file a petition within 14 days of appointment requiring that the vacancy be filled by special election.

Salary for the 2023 fiscal year is \$149,207 including benefits and IPERS.
