**About Juvenile Prosecutor I:**

Represents the State in prosecution of juvenile delinquencies, children in need of assistance proceedings, waivers to adult court, juvenile mental health commitments, termination of parental rights, modifications, and emergency removal of children.

**Essential Duties:**

- Reads and reviews child abuse assessments, consults with human services and other child protection professionals, decides upon filing, and litigates Child in Need of Assistance (CINA) cases
- Determines appropriate criminal charges against minors by reviewing law enforcement reports and applying Iowa law in juvenile delinquency matters
- Appears on behalf of the State of Iowa and/or Linn County for court hearings and trial in CINA and juvenile delinquency cases
- Advises Juvenile Court Officers and DHA case workers by answering questions and giving advice regarding legal issues and case management issues before and through the course of cases
- Meets with witnesses to confer with them and prepare them to testify at trials and hearings, prepares exhibits for trial

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- Work requires completion of a Juris Doctorate
- Over one year of experience is required
